How much is the scholarship?

1. For the cover crops workshop at Indiana Hort Conference the scholarship will cover a one-day registration to IHC, reimburse round-trip mileage, and cover the cost of lodging if needed.

What is expected of scholarship recipients?

1. Attend the event.
2. Use knowledge gained back home to teach students, clients, employees, other farmers, or to update educational programs or resources
3. Respond to a survey 6 months after event.

How do I apply?

When will I learn if my application is accepted?

1. Successful applicants will be notified by email by Jan. 13, 2020. Scholarship recipients will then need to register for the event themselves. Recipients will also need to make any needed hotel reservation themselves. Instructions will be provided.

How do scholarship recipients claim the funds?

1. Recipients will receive a code to use when registering for the event.
2. Mileage and, if approved, lodging, will be reimbursed after the event. Scholarship recipients will be provided forms and instructions.
